

REGULATION

1. GENERAL RULES

- 1.1. MASTER ATHLETICS International Meeting (MAIM) it's an international masters competition organized by Associação de Atletismo da Região Autónoma da Madeira (AARAM).
- 1.2. The competition will be held according with WA and WMA regulations.
- 1.3. All athletes are covered by local organisation insurance.
- 1.4. When athletes make their registration in the meeting, they may choose to participate in the number of events they wish, accordingly with the timetable.
 - 1.4.1. The organization may need to adjust the programme or timetable accordingly to the number of athletes assigned on each event.
 - 1.4.2. The organization undertakes to carry out the events in which there are, at least, three athletes registered.
- 1.5. Athletes must compete accordingly with their age group by the date of the meeting.
- 1.6. Each athlete is responsible for their own physical fitness degree.
- 1.7. In throws and horizontal jumping events, there will be 3+3 attempts to all athletes.
- 1.8. The initial height of the bar, for both high jump and pole vault, will be determined by the organization on the competition day, accordingly with the athletes assigned on the event.
- 1.9. Any issue missing in this regulation will be held by organization according with the national and international regulations.

2. MADEIRA MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS (CRV)

2.1. Simultaneously will occur the Madeira Masters Championships (only master athletes affiliated with AARAM are entitled to participate).





3. REGISTRATION, FEE AND CONFIRMATION

- 3.1. Registrations are made on Lap2go platform with a link available on the event site.
- 3.2. The registration fee is **20€** allowing to participate in **one event**.
 - 3.2.1. There will be an additional fee of 10€ for each additional event assigned.
- 3.3. The entries for MAIM will close on January 20 at 23h59.
- 3.4. On competition day, athletes must confirm their participation before the start of the meeting (till 30 minutes before).

4. PRIZES AND CLASSIFICATIONS

- 4.1. In this meeting there will be no team classification.
- 4.2. There will be individual classification in each event, by gender and age group.
- 4.3. A medal will be awarded to the winner in each event, by gender and age group.
- 4.4. All MAIM participants will receive a commemorative medal of the meeting.

5. CALL ROOM

- 5.1. There will be a call room by the south track entrance.
- 5.2. Times to access to call room and track entrance (Ribeira Brava):
 - ➤ Races 15 and 10 minutes before event time
 - ➤ High jump 25 and 20 minutes before event time
 - ➤ Pole vault 30 and 25 minutes before event time
 - > Other field events 20 and 15 minutes before event time
- 5.3. On events that will take place at the military facilities (RG3), **hammer** and **shot put**, athletes must have their **ID/Passport** to access the facility. All confirmations are made on site.
